

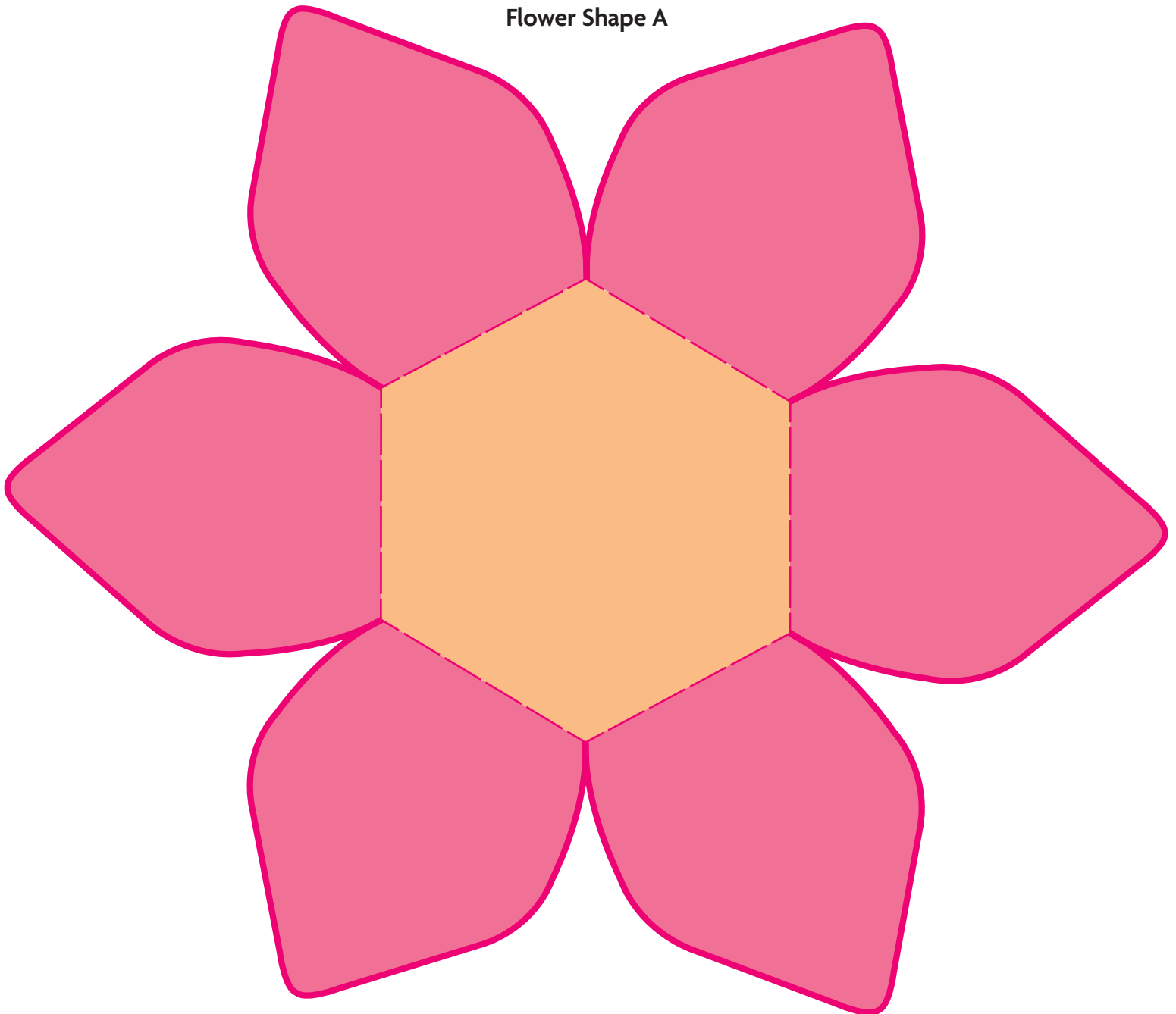


# Folding Flower Basket



1. Cut Flower Shapes A and B along the thick colored lines. Fold the petals up from the base at the dashed line.
2. Starting with Flower Shape A, use adhesive dots to overlap the flower petals so that they form a basket shape. On Flower Shape A, adhesive dots should be placed on the inside of the petals.
3. Using a pencil or writing tool, roll the tips of the flower petals outward around it to create a slight curled effect.
4. Follow the same steps for Flower Shape B. On Flower Shape B, adhesive dots should be placed on the outside of the petals.
5. When both baskets are complete, place an adhesive dot on the outside of Flower Shape B's bottom panel; then place Flower Shape B inside Flower Shape A, affixing the two baskets while making sure that the inner basket's petals fit the gaps in the outer basket's petals.
6. Use a hole punch and string or ribbon to make a loop handle for the basket.
